Meeting with Executive Leadership of New Mexico; December 12, 2024
The Chair met with the Governor's Chief of Staff to discuss the BSA's Co-Investment bill to which he expressed a commitment from executive leadership to support the state's bioscience industry. Also discussed were ideas for infrastructure, management of infrastructure funds and entities for investment oversight.
<u>UNM Business and Economic Summit – New Mexico: A</u> Leader in Entrepreneurship - January 15, 2025
The Chair attended the summit along with NMBSA Director Greg Byrnes to participate in discussions for building New Mexico's Bioscience sector.
City of Santa Fe Town Hall Meeting; January 15, 2025
At the meeting, New Mexico Senator Peter Wirth informed attendees of the state's massive budget surplus which should be an indicator for investment in New Mexico. As the surplus relates to the current legislative session, the chair, who attended the town hall meeting with BSA Directors Alex Koglin and Greg Byrnes, mentioned that

		The final draft of the Co-Investment bill has been reviewed by the staff of New Mexico Senator George Munoz who have expressed satisfaction with the current draft. Staffers were pleased with the language used in the bill and how key items were addressed. ED Tofighi confirmed BSA Staff will attend the 2025 legislation session to educate legislators on the bill.
		New Mexico Bioscience Authority Visit: Los Alamos National Labs (LANL) - January 14, 2025
		The event allowed about 30 participants to tour and learn about LANL's bio division's research facilities and to network among researchers, key industry stakeholders and entrepreneurs. Participants also discussed ideas to facilitate partnerships and effective methods to promote the transfer of research technology.
		Los Alamos National Laboratories (LANL) Celebrate & Support New Mexico's Deep Tech Entrepreneurs event; January 15, 2025, Santa Fe New Mexico
		ED Tofighi, NMBSA Director Alex Koglin, and NMBSA Program Specialist Sterling Nichols attended the Deep Tech event to learn about the current bioscience and agricultural science related research conducted by LANL researchers and LEEP Fellows. The event also presented an opportunity to promote the BSA's New Mexico Bioscience Ecomap.

Cangiolosi said he will inform the BOD if there is a co-sponsor.</li> <li><b>Expansion of BSA Budget</b> – Cangiolosi reported that he is working with New Mexico State Representative Meredith Dixon to increase the budget. Dixon is working on including the increase directly in House Bill 2 which lays out the state's budget for the year.</li> <li><b>Attend Legislative Committee Hearings</b> – Cangiolosi made it imperative for the BOD to try and attend committee hearings. Testifying to committee members about the Co-Investment Bill and the BSA's budget increase would be ideal to garner further support for approval at the legislature.</li> <li>SPD Cangiolosi concluded his update on the 2025 Legislative Session.</li> </ul>
